Strictly speaking, The Gospel of Luke is anonymous, but Luke the physician and companion of Paul is probably the author of the Gospel by his name. He was also the author of its companion work, The Book of Acts. Luke-Acts makes up 28% of the New Testament--more than that written by either Paul or John.

Matthew ' s Gospel, the most influential of the four Gospels Christians inherited from the first century of believers, was written in Antioch in Syria, then the third largest city in the Roman Empire after Rome and Alexandria. Some three or four years after the death of Jesus, Paul of Tarsus was received into the Christian community and baptised in Damascus, the ancient capital of Syria.
